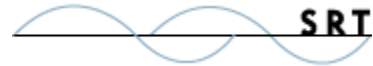

## Overview & Conditions

This guide will show you how to do edit the current 32-bit Cornerstone MFT installation to remove all references to 32-bit registry settings and system/program file locations. This process will allow you to successfully upgrade from 32-bit to 64-bit Cornerstone.



**Warning:** Serious problems could occur if you modify the registry incorrectly. These problems might require reinstallation of the operating system. Modify the registry at your own risk.

### Conditions

This procedure assumes a 64-bit Operating System, an existing 32-bit version of Cornerstone and a need to upgrade to 64-bit Cornerstone on the same machine. It also assumes a SQL data source.

**NOTE:** If you are not currently using SQL, and want to migrate to SQL Server or SQL Server Express 2005, you must migrate your database **before** you upgrade your Cornerstone.

## Procedure

### Exporting the Registry Keys

1. Stop the Cornerstone Server Daemon. To do this, go to the **Services applet panel** and stop the **Cornerstone Daemon service**. You must also stop the Cornerstone Administrator program and the Cornerstone Tray applet.
2. After you have stopped the Cornerstone Server Service, click **Start | Run** and launch **regedit.exe**. Browse to **[HKEY\_LOCAL\_MACHINE\SOFTWARE\Wow6432Node\South River Technologies\Cornerstone MFT\Servers** and locate the **Servers folder**.
3. Export the registry key: right-click and select **Export**.
4. On the **Export Registry File** dialog window, type a **File name** and change **Save as type** to **Win9x/NT4 Registration Files**, and then click **Save**. In our example, we named the file "Cornerstone". Store this file in a safe place; this is your backup .reg file.

### Editing the Registry Keys

1. Using WordPad, open the Registry key and make the following changes using **Find and Replace**. Type **Wow6432Node\** into the *Find what* box and leave the *Replace with* dialog box empty. Depending on how many servers you have, this may take a while. Once complete, save the file with a **new name**. For example, "Cornerstone64.reg".

## Upgrading Cornerstone to 64-bit Version

1. Depending on your operating system, use the **Add/Remove** program or **Programs and Features** program to uninstall the 32-bit version of Cornerstone Server.
2. When prompted to reboot, select **No**.
3. Open **Regedit** and delete **HKEY\_Local\_Machine\software\wow6432node\South River Technologies**
4. Reboot your computer.
5. Install the 64-bit Cornerstone Server and reboot if prompted.
6. In Windows Explorer, double-click the **.reg** file to import it into Cornerstone Server. In our example, we called this file "Cornerstone64.reg".

## Reactivating your License

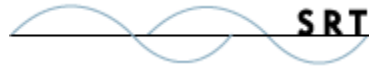
1. To reactivate your license, launch the Cornerstone Administrator. From the Help menu, select **License Information**.
2. Click **Reactivate License**. The *Product License Activation Wizard* will appear.
3. Type your registration code and then click **Next**.
4. Click **Activate**. You must have an active Internet connection for this step.
5. When you receive the message that your license has been activated, click **OK**, and then click **Finish**.

## Verifying the Upgrade

### To verify that your upgrade was successful:

1. Verify Server configuration for FTP, FTPS, SFTP, and if applicable, the Web User Interface.
2. Make sure users and groups exist.
3. Verify Files/Directories for Users, Groups, and Servers.
4. Test user/login connectivity.

You are now running the 64-bit version of Cornerstone MFT.
